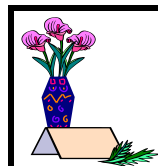

Fathers Day 2012. I am thinking about three fathers today that have shaped my life. My father would be the first. Dads are men that are likely pretty normal compared to everybody else, but special to their offspring. My father was not a super hero. He was not faster than a speeding bullet, more powerful than a locomotive, or could jump tall buildings with a single bound. Neither did he wear a disguise. He was always the same. He was faithful. He was predictable. He went to work every day and came home at the end of the same. He planted a garden in the spring and again in the fall. I don't remember him ever spending a night away from home. He hugged us and told us often of his love and pride for his family. I could not ask for more.

The second father is my two sons. They were not fathers when they began teaching me, mostly with questions, sometimes with pushing the limits of my patience. I would not have been a father without them. And in recent days, one of them has become a father himself. It is the most amazing thing in the world to watch your child become a parent. In that moment they know you better than they ever have. A light dawns in them, wisdom you wish they had possessed a decade earlier, but knowledge that could not come until their own children stepped out of their hopes and dreams and into their arms. Andy is a good father and will be again if he chooses. So will Todd.

There is a third father in my life. Jesus called him Abba. I don't speak Aramaic. I just call him father. I've known him as long as I can remember. My own father introduced me to him. He calls me by name. He tells me he loves me and is proud of me. He watched me become a father and taught me new things through the experience. He has been faithful, although not always predictable. He has blessed me beyond measure. He has forgiven my sins. He enjoys my company and I his. He is my heavenly father, savior, Lord, guide, defender, redeemer, shepherd, and friend. He has prepared a place for me. I will live there forever with him.

There are 22 spots available on the FBC vans to travel to Arlington for the game. Vans will leave at 3:30 p.m. Cost is \$10.

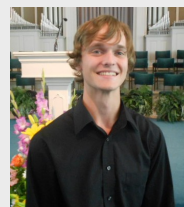
