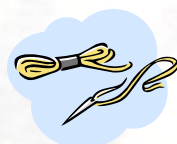

Independence Day 2014. In an unusual schedule for Debbie and me we were home for the 4th. Our normal practice is to spend the holiday on the busy streets of Pitkin, Colorado, watching a parade of decorated bicycles, ATVs, a fire truck from the volunteer fire department, and a few walkers in homemade costumes. We grill burgers, drink root beer floats, and eat watermelon that spent the night in a net bag anchored to the shore of an ice cold stream. Colorado melons aren't as tasty as those grown by George Ogden. Before dark we drive into Gunnison for the fireworks. It's how we celebrate our freedom.



On Monday of this week the Supreme Court handed down its decision on the Hobby Lobby case. The debate moved quickly from the halls of justice to the pages of Facebook and the partisan airwaves of today's radio and television. The hearing has produced cheering, jeering, and sneering. This too, is how we celebrate our freedom. We are free to disagree...in public...with passion! It is not every place in the world where you can do this.

I am a follower of Jesus. He did not ask me to follow Him when the government allowed it or when society encouraged it. He did not ask me to follow Him when it was popular or easy to do so. He asked me to follow him first, regardless of the cost. He invited me to join Him in showing the world the better way of love, forgiveness, and grace.

We are free from government coercion in the practice of our faith. We are not free from our Lord's call to be His people on mission with Him to bring the Kingdom of God "on earth as it is in Heaven." Let us do more than celebrate freedom. Let us celebrate the call of Jesus by exercising our responsibilities as His followers. When we follow Him we will go about doing good, as He did. We will bring others with us.
