

PASTOR'S ADVISORY COMMITTEE

PURPOSE OF THE COMMITTEE:

To function as a support and advisory group to the pastor.

DUTIES OF THE COMMITTEE:

1. To make the pastor aware of ministry needs and opportunities in the church.
2. To serve as a "sounding board" for ministry ideas of the pastor.
3. To keep the pastor informed of potential problem areas in pastor/staff/congregational relationships.
4. To make recommendations to the Stewardship Committee concerning the pastor's salary and benefits.
5. To assist the pastor in assessing and evaluating the general status of the church and suggest ways by which the church may more effectively fulfill its mission.
6. To encourage the pastor in his leadership role through prayer and such other means as may be appropriate.

ORGANIZATION OF THE COMMITTEE:

The committee shall consist of six (6) members nominated by the Committee on Committees and elected by the church. Each member shall be elected for a term of three years, with two terms expiring each year. One member shall be nominated by the Committee on Committees to serve as chairman and shall be elected by the church to serve in that capacity for one year.
