Dear First Family,

Last Sunday night we began studying Romans 12:3-8. In these verses, we took up the subject of Thinking. Under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit, Paul moved from Consecrate your Bodies (12:1) to Concentrate your Minds (12:2). Thinking, as the subject of 12:3-8, is the logical next step.

The first thing about which Paul instructed every Christian to think was themselves. Paul did not mean think about the church as a total group, but for each person to think about himself or herself. Specifically, Paul said we are not to think more highly of ourselves than we ought. As we looked closely at this text, we came to understand that Paul's admonition also meant not to think too lowly of ourselves. Everyone in the church needs to have the proper perspective, understanding that we were created in the image of God, saved from our sins, and positionally righteous in Christ. That means that we should neither run ourselves down, nor think we are indispensable. We must remember that we are working in God's Kingdom for God's purpose and not our own.

Join us in the Brick tonight at 6:00 when we will continue to draw instruction on our Christian behavior from Paul's epistle to the Romans. And remember: CHURCH is the SUNDAY NIGHT PLACE TO BE!
