# Sunday Evening Worship

Dear First Family,

In Romans 12:3-8, Paul indicated the Christian life is to be one of intentional thought. Stated another way, Christians are to think. First, we are to think about ourselves. In this we are to avoid undervaluing ourselves, which is to diminish God's work in our lives, and overvaluing ourselves, which is vanity.

Second, we are to think about others. In this context, Paul meant that we are to think about the Church. By using the anatomy of the body, Paul said the Church has uniqueness, togetherness, and oneness. Finally, Paul said we are to think about spiritual gifts. On this point, Paul said God gives gifts to the Church, not to people. While it is true that people constitute the gathered Church and that the Holy Spirit gives gifts to the Church by empowering people, still the gifts are given to the Church. All of God's provision is to be used to further God's purposes, not our own.
